



Rules that MUST BE FOLLOWED when attending RMHS dances

- Students need to be dropped-off and picked-up from the North entrance.
- Students must have their school I.D. in order to be admitted to the dance.
- Students cannot leave the dance for any reason; once you leave the dance you will not be re-admitted.
- Anyone who behaves inappropriately (language, dancing) will be removed from the dance. Parents will be called to provide transportation home.
- All chaperones/security officers are supervisors. All students will obey the directions given by chaperones.
- No soda, candy or gum is allowed in the gym. All refreshments must be consumed in the “refreshment” area located in the lobby gym.
- Students who misbehave are subject to the High School discipline code.
- All students will be searched prior to entering the dance, and students suspected of being under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be admitted to the dance and will be dealt with by the administration
- A STRICT DRESS CODE will be in effect for the dance. This is a semi-formal dance. The dress code is the same as the dress code for school. Here are some PROHIBITED items of clothing:
 - Hats, T-Shirts, Short Skirts / Dresses, and excessively revealing clothing

All students must be picked up from the RMHS campus no later than 10:45pm to insure their safety and supervision. Any student picked-up after 10:45pm will be excluded from attending future dances at RMHS.
