- No Approval of Minutes from October 17, 2017 due to not enough participants present.

- Student Report
 - Emily Orozco reported that RMHS football made it to CIF, tennis team went to finals with select single players making it to CIF. Additional sports such as cross country, volleyball, basketball, golf, and soccer updates.
 - Fright night was on Halloween.

Mrs. Haga shared that our staff may take a look at these points and see how we can improve. Mrs. Haga suggested we take a look at the results so that we can discuss student concerns next time we meet.

- SPSA going to approval tonight, November 14, 2017.
- Mrs. Haga approved monies for 11th grade PSAT for payment from Title 1 Funds, however she shared the district informed her that this request was not a qualification of Title I Funds. Mrs. Haga explained the redistribution of some funds, with rearrangement of monies distributed primarily to benefit student needs such as field trips.
- Mrs. Haga also discussed that fee waiver turn out has been poor and the school therefore has been having to fund a large portion of the PSAT. Funds will be coming out of a College Readiness Block Grant.
- Mr. Belliveau will be sent to a Link Crew conference to learn and gather information regarding helping students achieve college readiness.
- Ms. Ballard commented that English and history teachers have reached out to students in class to get the word out that they need to turn in the fee waiver for the PSAT.
